Pastor's Corner

I've said it before and I'll say it again—time flies, especially when good times are had.

As of January 2, 2025, we've been together in

this interim ministry for a year. As you know, we'll be together for another year-long extension. It's been a full year, and there's good work to be done as we extend our interim ministry together. Here is a map of where we are headed in the coming year:

Mission Study Report to be shared with session, approved by the COM (Committee on Ministry, which is a presbytery committee), and distributed to the congregation. Working with the Mission Study Team, I anticipate this step to be completed in the spring, sometime in April - May.

Ministry Discernment Profile (MDP) created for Bayside. The MDP is the church's profile that is used on our denomination's website for candidates searching for a call. The COM approves when the church is ready to create & upload its MDP.

Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC) members to be nominated & voted at a congregational meeting, typically at the same time when we approve a new class of elders. This meeting usually happens in the fall, routinely in October.

The search process for a called and installed pastor & head of staff is a lengthy, important, and special one. May we start **praying as a church body for the right fit**. For the pastor to be prepared for a new call, a new congregation, and for a new vision of leadership and discipleship at Bayside. For us to ready ourselves as a church family. What joy it will be for both Bayside & the pastor when the match happens.

There is much to do before then.

Every step is part of the process, so may we **continue to be faithful** in the good work the good Lord gives us this day.


HAPPY NEW YEAR FROM THE PRESCHOOL!




